
## April 17 - Easter Sunday

Years ago, Gina and I were in a musical called Jekyll & Hyde, a musical production loosely based on Robert Louis Stevenson's story. In the musical, there is a woman named Lucy who falls for Jekyll. After realizing that Hyde is too unpredictable, Jekyll tells Lucy to leave and forget she ever met him. As a result, she sings the song, "A New Life."



As one listens to the song, it's easy to hear the angst of what it must be like for one who does not know Jesus. There is a desperate inner cry for

meaning in life magnified by the life-long experience of not finding it. Imagine searching for meaning in your life and never being able to find it. Throughout the song, Lucy shares what she wants out of life: a new start, a new hope, a new chance, a new dream... a new life. Of course, without Jesus, these are all empty dreams on which the world can never deliver.

But as we celebrate Easter this month, it is a great time to be reminded that we have been given a new life in Jesus. In fact, all of our longing for meaning, for hope, for a new dream, a new chance at life *are* met in the resurrection of Jesus from the grave! Our hopes and dreams can be magnified by our experience of the Risen Christ because He has given us His Spirit. As Romans 8:11 says, "And, if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, then he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who lives in you."

Think of that! The same Spirit that raised Jesus back to life – is living in you! Your hope for a second chance at life is now possible: your chance at new hope is possible; your desire for a a new world; your ability to dream a new dream with God – all are possible because Jesus lives! He is alive! The grave would be the last obstacle for any of us. Death would seem to bring all possibilities to a screeching halt. But at the resurrection, God put an exclamation point on life! And you and I can be a part of it.

Are you experiencing a new life in Christ? Does your life today look more like Jesus' life? Or more like your old self? I hope you will be able to spend some time this month in Scripture looking at the Bible accounts of the resurrection. Spend some time in prayer, asking God to bring you new life. Meditate on the resurrection and where you might be experiencing it in your own life. And as you do, allow your heart to be filled with praise.

Our God is amazing!

## \* \* Church Wide Movie Night \* \*



Clavius, a powerful Roman military tribune, and his aide Lucius, are tasked with solving the mystery of what happened to [Jesus] in the weeks following the crucifixion, in order to disprove the rumors of a risen Messiah and prevent an uprising in Jerusalem."

This movie is rated PG 13 for Biblical violence.

## National Day Of Prayer

Join with us, along with other Americans all over the United States, as we gather for praise and prayer here at St. Matthew at 12:00 noon on Thursday, May 5.

The theme of the 2022 National Day of Prayer is: "Exalt The Lord, Who Has Established Us", based on Colossians 2:6 - 7. "As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving."

Although the National Day Of Prayer was officially signed into law in 1952 by President Harry S. Truman, the practice of praying for our country was really nothing new. Ever since our nation's founding, our leaders have always called for days of prayer, thanksgiving and fasting.

The National Day of Prayer takes place every year on the first Thursday of May. In fact, over 40,000 prayer gatherings are held every year at churches, court houses, temples, synagogues and schools - which means millions of people are in prayer on that day. We invite you to join us to be one of them at St. Matthew on Thursday, May 4 at noon in the Sanctuary.
