# The Pastors Pen

"Are you healthy?" Those three words carry a different weight at age 18 than age 78, don't they? At 18, we hardly consider the question because we take it for granted that by and large, we are healthy. But by age 78, we may be facing much more. I was surprised to recently learn according to one source, the fitness industry in 2021 was worth \$160 Billion. That number is expected to be \$435 Billion by 2028. Seems we are willing to invest to be physically healthy! (*These numbers are taking into consideration*; *gym memberships, meal plans, supplements, and fitness wear, etc.*)



Yet with our apparent obsession over being physically healthy, I wonder if people have the same devotion to their spiritual health.

With that question in mind, it bears asking: Do you have a spiritual prayer life? When you think of the time you spend in prayer, is it best described as a quick conversation at the fast food drive-through, or as a conversation with a loved one in which you lose track of time? On my first date with Gina, I took her home, we sat in the car and talked for 4 hours in the driveway. We lost all track of time because we were finding out so much about the other. We enjoyed our conversation so much, we completely lost track of time.

When we pray to the Lord, the same thing can happen. We can lose track of time because of all that we are saying, hearing, being reminded of, and being overwhelmed by awe as we come into his presence.

So for the month of February, we will be looking at what are the marks of a Healthy Prayer Life. If you have ever struggled with prayer, or wondered what to do with (seemingly) unanswered prayer or wondered what would you say if you had to pray for an hour, you won't want to miss this month at church as we focus on having a Healthy Prayer Life.

We will also be inviting everyone to a special individual prayer time through the month of February, which you will hear more of through the worship services. I believe God has given us a priceless gift called Prayer. But if our prayer life is unhealthy, we won't be able to experience it in its fullness.

One of the most beautiful things about prayer to me is that when we pray, Heaven is invited to earth!
