- Prophecy: Delivering messages inspired by God.
- Serving/Ministry: Assisting others in practical ways.
- Teaching: Explaining and applying biblical truths.
- **Encouragement**: Offering comfort and motivation.
- Giving: Generosity with resources.
- Leadership: Guiding others effectively.
- Mercy: Showing deep empathy and compassion.
- Wisdom: Providing godly advice and insight.
- **Knowledge**: Understanding deep truths in Scripture.
- Faith: Exhibiting strong trust in God.
- Healing: Miraculously curing illnesses.
- Miracles: Performing supernatural acts.
- **Discernment**: Distinguishing between truth and error.
- Tongues: Speaking unknown languages.
- Interpretation of Tongues: Translating those languages.
- Apostleship: Starting new churches and ministries.

- **Helps**: Supporting others in their tasks.
- Administration: Organizing and managing.
- **Evangelism**: Sharing the Christian faith.
- **Shepherding/Pastoring**: Guiding and caring for believers.
- **Celibacy**: Choosing a life without marital relations.
- Hospitality: Welcoming and hosting others.
