hymn arrangements and light classical music performed by some of the most talented worship pianists in the area. This is a must see event for music lovers of all ages. Get your family and friends together and make your reservation today! I have a fountain in my office I have always appreciated. It sits on a table opposite my desk. It looks like light gray stone within a black stone frame. I remember once watching the water trickle over the rock and I began to think, "You don't see that every day! Water doesn't come from a rock." Then I was reminded how the Israelites in the desert were thirsty and complained to Moses. (Out of their thirst, they complained). Moses cried out to God and God led Moses to a rock on Horeb, (see Exodus 17 and Numbers 20), where Moses struck the rock and God provided water for all His people. This too, is not "normal."



Water doesn't flow from a rock. Water flows from a well when pumped. It flows in a stream. It flows from a faucet. Water can flow under a rock, around a rock and even over a rock, but it doesn't flow from a rock!

Yet it did. Was it natural? No. Was it normal? No. Was it necessary? I believe so. Maybe God wanted the Israelites to see that with God, nothing is impossible. Maybe God wanted the Israelites to see that God could do anything, and, that God had their best interest always at heart and they could trust Him to lead them.

But the Israelites questioned. They grumbled. They complained. Perhaps they just couldn't trust that God would continue to take care of them in the face of a scorching hot desert. I suppose we do too. Sometimes we focus so intently on the situations in our lives that we forget we are accompanied in life by the One who loves us and refuses to leave us orphaned. Perhaps you find yourself in such a situation today.

If so, may I remind you that the God who can bring water out of a rock can bring refreshment to you in whatever desert you are facing. You have the Holy Spirit, who comes up along side of you and is with you through all of life. Jesus is with you through His Spirit, and in Jesus, we find we never have to thirst again.

Writing about the Israelites in the desert, Paul addressed the church in Corinth saying, "All were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea. All ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink. They drank from a spiritual rock that followed them and the rock was Christ." (1 Cor. 10:2-4)

So if you're tempted to focus only on the "rock" in front of you, thinking that the situation is beyond redemption, start looking for the water. Remember that the God who brings forth water from a rock is with you, and He will quench your thirsting soul.


