## Attempt #1: Irreverence (2 Samuel 6:1-11)

- Begins with small compromises that seem harmless at first. (Song of Songs 2:15)
   Prioritizes what's convenient or right in our own eyes. (Judges 21:25; Proverbs 14:12)
   Views God as someone we can manage & control . (1 Samuel 15:22-23)
   Grieves angers & God & leads to serious consequences. (Leviticus 10:1-3; Acts 5:1-11)
- So David went down and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-Edom to the City of David with rejoicing. 2 Samuel 6:12

## Attempt #2: Reverence (2 Samuel 6:12-11-19)

- Is God's gracious remedy for our irreverence. (Proverbs 3:5-8; Proverbs 9:10; Proverbs 14:27; Proverbs 22:4; 1 Peter 5:5-6)
   Inquires of the LORD & doing what HE says. (1 Chronicles 15:11)
- Confesses & abandons any disobedience. (Psalms 32:1-9; Proverbs 28:13; 1 John 1:7-9)
- Believes the LORD chastens so He may bless us. (<u>Psalms 51:7-17</u>; <u>Hebrews 12:5-6</u>)
- LORD, show me any "slippage" so I may revere You. (Psalms 139:23-24)
